President's Volunteer Service Award (PVSA) FAQs:

What is the PVSA? It is an award that allows SLOBs members in good standing to combine SLOBs hours with philanthropy hours worked elsewhere to earn recognition for your service.

What do I get? PVSA Recipients receive a certificate of appreciation and a letter of thanks from the President of the United States.

The PVSA Award Categories:

HOURS BY AWARD	BRONZE	SILVER	GOLD
Kids (5-10)	26-49	50-74	75+
Teens (11-15)	50-74	75-99	100+
Young Adults (16-25)	100-174	175-249	250+
Adults (26 and older)	100-249	250-499	500+
Families and Groups	200-499	500-999	1000+

How do I get credit for my non-SLOBs hours? Use the worksheet available on the SLOBs website to track your hours through the years. You must get signature approval for your non-SLOBs hours.

How do I apply for the PVSA?

Simply submit your documentation and fee to the SLOBs administrator. Submit your non-SLOBs hours worksheet, a print out of your SLOBs hours, and a check for \$8.00 payable to MVLA SLOBs by May 4.

How do I know what age category I am in? Your age category is determined by your age at the beginning of the SLOBs year. The SLOBs year begins on May 1.
